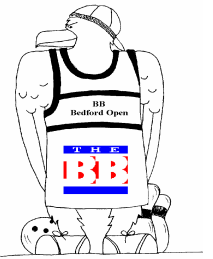




# The 19<sup>th</sup> Boys' Brigade National 10 Pin Bowling Championships

## The Championship

The championship is the premiere 10 pin bowling competition for the Brigade and will run all day from 10am. Team will be registered on a first come basis up to a maximum of 60 teams. The champion is decided after 3 rounds of random league bowling, (finishing around 2pm) followed by 3 knockout stages (to approximately 7.00pm for the finalists).

## The Teams

Teams are allowed from any BB Company, including Amicus Groups within the United Kingdom and Eire. A team will consist of 3 boys or girls of company section age (11-19), with the upper age limit < 20.00 and the lower age limit of ≥ 11.00 as at 9<sup>th</sup> October 2010.

West Anglia Battalion has hosted this competition since its inception. Accommodation can be provided for those travelling long distances, on Friday and /or Saturday night.

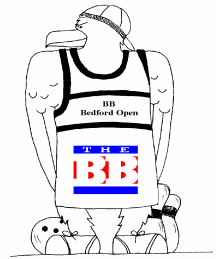

## The Main Championship will contain;

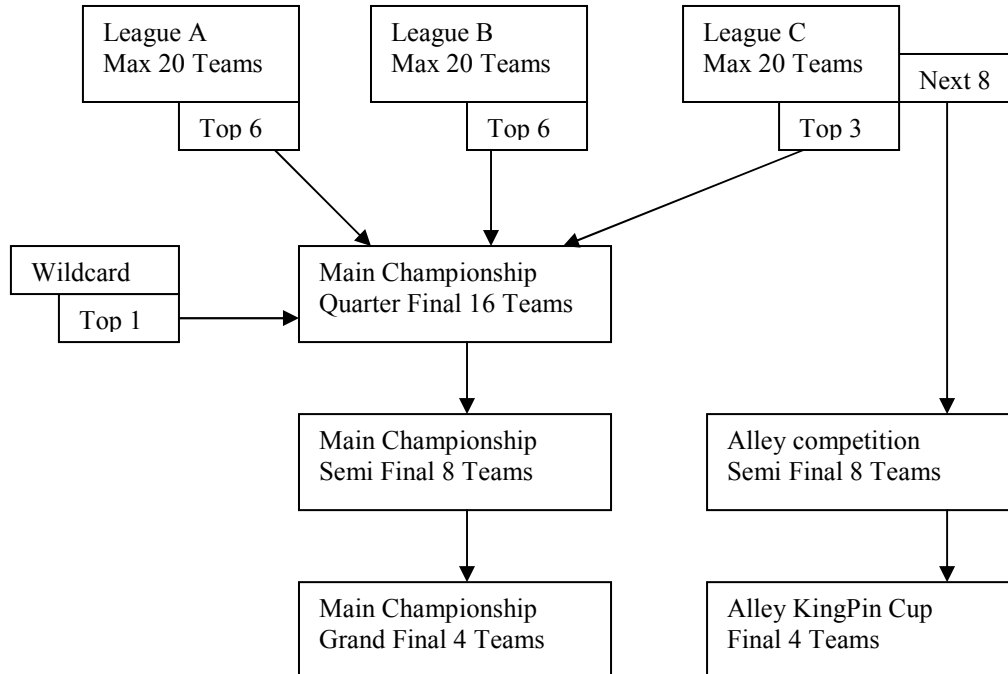
- First Teams Only
- Max of 40 teams, Split into two leagues [A & B] of 20. (Reduced from 64 teams [in 2003])
- The Top 6 Teams from each league will Qualify for the Main Championships Quarter Finals
- Top Age for these League is **19** and Under

## A Secondary Competition, known as the Alley, will contain;

- All 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Teams
- **Plus** any 1<sup>st</sup> Teams whose members are ALL 13 and Under
- Max of 20 Teams, All in 1 League [C] – **The Alley**
- The Top 3 Teams from this league will Qualify for the Main Championships Quarter Finals
- The Next 8 Teams from this league will Qualify for the Alley's Semi-Finals & play for the **KingPin Cup**
- Top Age for this League is **18** and under

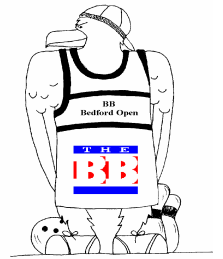
## Wildcard Entry

- The top scoring team from either of the 3 leagues, with 5 or more points, will qualify as the Wildcard entry into the Main Championship's Quarter final.

## How to Enter

An entry fee of £32 per team, comprising of a £20 non-refundable deposit and £12 refundable, if cancelled 14 days before the championship, is charged. This entry fee guarantees three games of bowling for each player and hospitality for all.

The completed entry form and fee are to be sent by post to the "Championship Administrator" by the closing date for entries of **31<sup>st</sup> July 2010**. The entry form may be sent by E-Mail and the place in the championship will be confirmed **once** the payment has been received by the closing date. Again championship places can only be confirmed on the receipt of the full championship fee.

Cheques are to be made payable to **"THE WEST ANGLIA BATTALION"**.

Upon registering, you will receive acknowledgement (usually end of calendar month). A receipt and further information will be sent out in two stages : Aug 2010 after the cut-off date and all teams are known, and Sep 2010 for final arrangements. Either by Royal Mail or E-Mail as indicated on the entry form as your preferred method of communication. E-Mail communication will be in either Word or Excel document attachments.

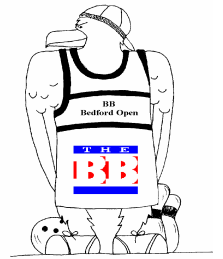
